commencing on 23 day of June

1850

Plantation during the week
Overseer.

- 23rd Sunday. The sick all on the mend except *Creary*.
Caroline sick to day took *Sobelie* & *Petry*
Took Sobelia N^o. Rain some threatening clouds
no rain
- 24th Monday. The hoe hands finished the *Sandrum* cotton field
at 12 o'clock & went to the *Spillers* field after dinner
Spillers the plow finished sweeping the *Park* field of corn
a little after dinner & commenced sweeping *Sandrum*
field some hands at new house all the sick went out,
25th Tuesday. ^{except *Caroline* & *Creary*} Hoes hands at the *Spillers* field plow finished
Sandrum field in the morning & commenced in the
Collard field still running sweep plow, *Harrel* &
Henry & *Bob* not well enough to work also *Creary* &
Caroline some much sick, & big rain 4 o'clock

- 26th Wednesday. Moved to our new place named *It*
Greenwood the land too wet to work all hands
that were well engaged moving & cleaning up or
at work on haws on the new place, no rain -
hauled 1 Load of corn
- 27th Thursday. Land too wet to work, had a heavy rain
a little before day & another shower about daylight

Rain to hard rain at 12 o'clock hands mostly employed as
yesterday about the new place, Hauled 3 loads of
corn from *Danville* making 28 loads in all
- 28th Friday. Land still too wet to work, Hands mostly at
work about the new place raised a log bay for *Bob*,
cleaning up about the lower well, no rain today but
showers peeping about
- 29th Saturday. No work in the plantation working about
new the place some hands getting plates & gutters for the
Rain east & west passage & some cutting up grebs about the
well, a hard rain about 2 o'clock
10 plows sent up to *Coopers* place plowed till
12 o'clock stopped by rain
